The Betty Ford Center Family Program helps family members and loved ones begin their recovery from the effects of the disease of alcoholism and other drug dependency.

This program is an intensive five-day experience (Monday-Friday) with group work, lectures and presentations addressing various dynamics of the disease.

This program provides family members and loved ones with the skills and tools necessary to begin their own healing process and develop their own resiliency.



Our Family Program is open to family members and loved ones, ages 13 and older. This program is available to any family member or loved one who has been, or is currently, impacted by addiction to alcohol and/or other drugs. It is not necessary to have a loved one in treatment to participate in this unique program.

Addiction is a disease that has a profound effect on the addicted individual, as well as on his/her loved ones.

Those completing the program receive the tools necessary to begin the process of recovery. The Family Program addresses the physical, emotional, mental and spiritual dimensions of those impacted by the disease of addiction.
